The oxygen generator is environmentally friendly, aesthetically pleasing and provides reliable supply without interruption. Class 1 on-site medical oxygen supply systems are a reliable, proven and modern method of providing oxygen. Built with innovative VSA technology for superior performance the system includes three sources of supply; primary, secondary and reserve.

Toronto real estate is some of the most costly and scarce in North America, so finding space for large outdoor oxygen storage as well as space for delivery trucks to provide oxygen can be difficult and expensive. However, installing an on-site oxygen generation system is cost-effective and does not require land for outdoor oxygen tank storage, concrete pads and fencing.

The oxygen system meets CSA-Z7396.1-17 and is monitored with Class 1's innovative mobile friendly OxyShield remote monitoring system to ensure a continuous, uninterrupted supply of medical-grade oxygen. The monitoring system allows the facility management and Class 1 service technicians to see real-time equipment status and oxygen quality to ensure peace of mind.

The project will add approximately 550,000 square feet to the existing hospital and will include a new eight-storey patient care tower and a three-storey connection.
